"But these are written so that you **may** come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing you **may** have life in his name." John 20:35

It's the only name of a month that is also a verb that is commonly used. Oxford dictionary defines May as:

- 1. expressing possibility. "that may be true"
- 2. expressing permission. "may I ask a few questions?"
- 3. expressing a wish or hope. "may she rest in peace"

These are interconnected but very different meanings.

The last verse of John uses the verb two times. That we may come to believe and that we may have life. I believe that all three definitions may be appropriate here. The gospel was written so that we have the possibility and permission to believe, and God truly hopes we will. Our believing gives us the possibility and permission to have eternal life, something that God truly wants us to have.

The Easter season continues through the month of May. As we celebrate the resurrection, let us have the same convictions about may as the author of John. Let us joyfully tell the story so that others may believe and may have life in Christ.
